'A voice of one crying out in the desert, Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight his paths." These words of the Prophet Isaiah are applied by Matthew to John the Baptist in our Gospel passage on this 2nd Sunday of Advent. Making paths straight is no small task, and John the Baptist is fierce in the way he calls the Jewish people to conversion, especially their leaders. Advent is a time to allow the Lord to straighten out our paths, and there's no reason to expect that will be easy or comfortable!

Our first goal this Advent should not be cards, gifts, or decorations (good but secondary), but rather spiritual preparation! I know: that's a tall order in this busy and heavily secularized season, but it is what Advent is for. Don't waste it!

No better preparation for Christmas exists than to make a good confession! We have FIVE penance services left, all around the vicariate, not to mention confession times every week as well! Awaken your heart and make room for the Lord by jettisoning your sins! Especially if it's been a long time, even decades, don't stay away from the Lord's mercy!

Please plan to join us for the Vicariate celebration of Advent Lessons and Carols at St. Joe's in Lake Linden this Tuesday, Dec. 6th at 7 pm.


