**From the desk of Fr. Ben... 30 April 2017**

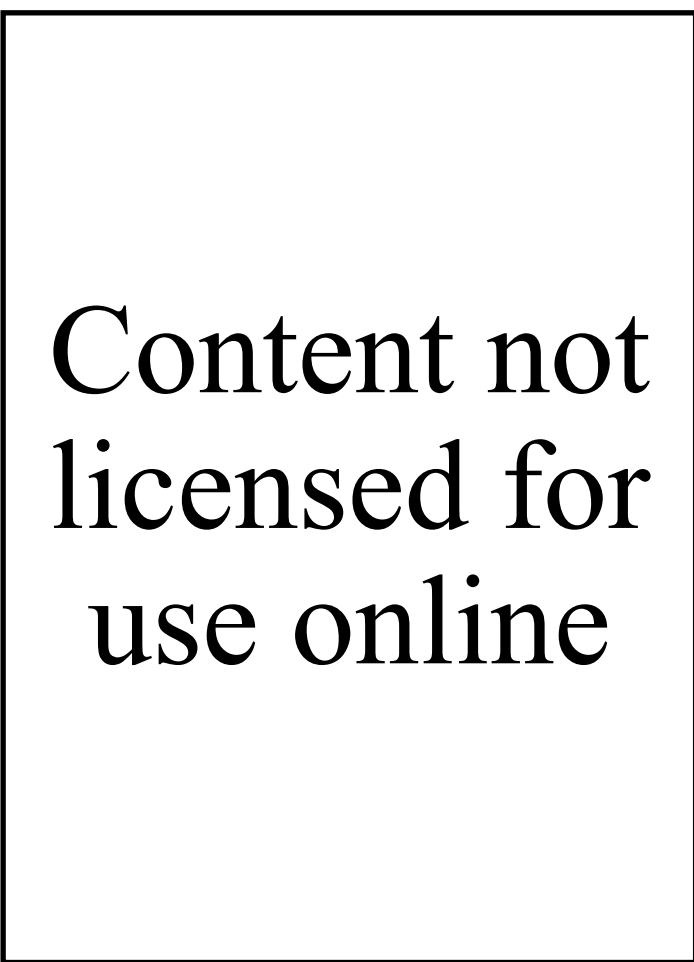
