Diocesan Priest Retirement Collection (May 14)

Retired priests of the Diocese of Marquette receive health and automobile insurance and a monthly pension from the St. Joseph Association, the diocesan priest retirement fund. Diocesan priests live independently during their retirement, and they use their pension for basic needs, such as food, housing and transportation. Parish assessments, plus growth in the St. Joseph Association, have fallen short of what is needed to provide necessary benefits to our retired priests. **All parishes and missions in the Diocese of Marquette will participate in a special collection on May 13/14 to help "bridge the gap."** It is essential that we ensure adequate retirement and health coverage in the years ahead for our priests. **Please return your collection envelope during next weekend's Masses.** - Fr.
