## From the desk of Fr. Ben...

21 May 2017



As you read this, hopefully I'll be enjoying my last full day in Italy with my parents & my sister Libby. We'll be spending most of our trip there in the town of Lucca, shown by the red marker on this map. We're celebrating my parents' 45<sup>th</sup> wedding anniversary, and I'm sure I'll have tales to tell when I return!

I'm very grateful to Fr. Corbin, whose generous service makes this vacation possible for me! It's been a busy year, & I'm glad to have a little time off with my family!

Our second reading today, from the First Letter of Peter, is the classic verse calling us to defend and explain the Faith: "Always be ready to give an explanation to anyone who asks you for a reason for your hope, but do it with gentleness and reverence..." Notice that the situation that is expected is one where the Christian's life is giving rise to curiosity, where we are living in such a way that others want to know where our hope comes from! We need to study and learn about the Catholic Faith so that we can understand it and live it joyfully and beautifully. If we bear that fruit by our lives, then others will want to share in it.

This is a gift we can ask for from God during this Easter season: **Lord, help me to live joyfully in your love, full of hope, and help these gifts to overflow such that others want to share them!**

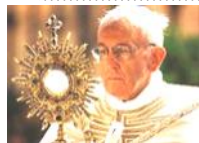
