St. Al's Sanctuary Renovation: After several years of discussion and fundraising, work has begun! The old carpet has been removed, and the sanctuary steps have been modified. Doors are being put on the two sacristy entrances for sound control and general security. Ceramic tile will be installed this coming week! This is the first phase of a project that will be completed in early August. The second part will involve removing the old pews and carpet, abating the underlying asbestos-bearing tile, installing new flooring (carpet under the pews and side aisles and side section, stone-appearance vinyl tile in the main aisle), and the installation of the new pews.

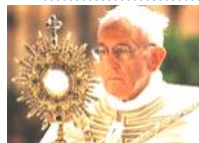
