install them in the side entrance (beside and above the door), and possibly in the stairwell downstairs as well. Several families have already spoken to me about sponsoring a window. The cost per window to have them restored and installed will be in the \$12,000 to \$15,000 range (versus \$40,000 to \$60,000 to purchase new stained glass windows). Our whole Lenten and Easter journey reaches its fruition in the great feast we celebrate today: **Pentecost, the sending of the Holy Spirit upon the Church!** Sometimes we say it is the “birthday of the Church,” for it is by the

power of the Holy Spirit, the Fire of Love, that the Apostles were given the courage and wisdom they needed to preach the Gospel to all nations!

**The Third Person of the Holy Trinity, the Holy Spirit, is the most mysterious and most difficult to image.** The Scriptures give us various images: fire, wind, power, water, a dove! The tradition speaks of “the love between the Father and the Son.” Jesus describes an advocate, a counselor, the Paraclete.
