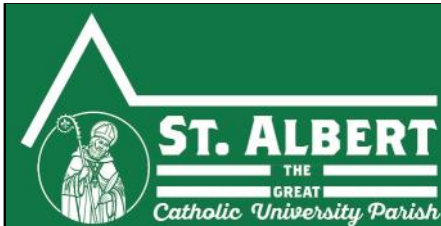

Words of Wisdom from Bishop Frederic Baraga

Among 70 other bishops, Bishop Baraga assisted at the wedding of Emperor Franz Joseph and Elisabeth as a representative of the American church. A chalice given to Baraga by the Emperor Franz Joseph is in the Diocese of Marquette Archives.

A VERY warm welcome to all students, both new and returning, from Michigan Tech, Finlandia, and Gogebic Community College, and to your families as well! It is exciting to begin a new semester with you! After a recent retreat, a student wrote:

“While so many universities have proven to be places where young people's faith is lost, here at Tech we are blessed to have a place like St. Al's to fan the flames of our faith and be a light to our community.”

I can't imagine a better summary of our mission: St. Al's is a Catholic parish where the spark of faith in our hearts is fanned into a flame, where we come to love Jesus Christ and His Church, and where together we become an ever brighter light of faith, hope, and love in our community! **Welcome aboard!**

Our second reading has some very beautiful language speaking of the **Heavenly Wedding Feast of the Lamb**, in which we participate at every Eucharist:

“No, you have approached Mount Zion and the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and countless angels in festal gathering, and the assembly of the firstborn enrolled in heaven, and God the judge of all, and the spirits of the just made perfect, and Jesus, the mediator of a new covenant, and the sprinkled blood that speaks more eloquently than that of Abel.”



This is what we are invited to experience, that into which we enter at the Mass! The building, the music, the vestments, the sacred vessels, the readings, the homily... **all of it is meant to prepare us and draw us into this encounter with the Living God!** I know that wasn't on my radar screen AT ALL during most of the time I was growing up, beyond a sort of vague notion that I was receiving Jesus in some fashion. As we are exhorted to become more deeply aware of what we experience, of He Whom we receive, **may our hearts be open to the fullness of the mystery offered to us!**

It has been a **VERY full week at St. Al's** with all of our O-week activities. We had over 360 people at Mass last Sunday, of whom we served lunch afterwards to over 200! We've had good attendance at our orientation events, as well as at training for returning students. We've given out many Bibles, catechisms, and St. Al's t-shirts. All told, it adds up to a very good beginning. **Thank you very much to everyone who has**



helped out this week. It's been a lot of work, but also very joyful and fruitful!

My gratitude also to so many people who have given generously during our **Matching Collection Challenge!** As of Saturday morning, we have received **\$11,764.85**, surpassing our **\$10,000** goal even before this Sunday's collections! Thank you! *God Bless, Fr. Ben*
