Come Holy Spirit! As we celebrate Pentecost, we mark the climactic conclusion of the Easter season, and the door that leads to the living out of the truth and joy of Easter!!! The very Fire of Love is poured out upon the Apostles, the Blessed Mother, and upon us! Come Holy Spirit!

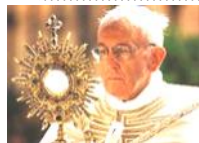
