St. Al's Sanctuary Renovation: Dollar Bay Tile finished the tile and grout in the sanctuary, and Chassell Carpentry has installed new doors on the sacristy. All that's left in the sanctuary is the trim at the base of the wall. In early August, we will remove the old pews and carpet, abate the underlying asbestos-bearing tile, install new flooring (carpet under the pews and side aisles and side section, stone-appearance vinyl tile in the main aisle), and the new pews.

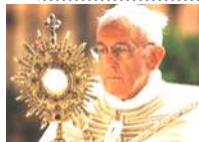
