



An anonymous survey at a Catholic high school indicated that 70% of the students reported viewing pornography several times per week or more, while only 11% of the students reported that they did not view pornography. 

From the desk of Fr. Ben...

29 October 2017



Love is the greatest commandment! Praise God! But, to quote a widely-played pop song, "What is love?"

Jesus, who gives this commandment, also models for us what perfect love looks like: the total gift ourselves, even unto death, even when that gift involves pouring out our lives in service and in sacrifice! Love isn't always bloody... but in a fallen world, all authentic love will involve us in sacrifice. The Way of the

Cross leads to the beauty and joy of the Resurrection! The Cross is indeed the Tree of Life!

As the leaves are falling, the days are getting shorter. **On** Wednesday we celebrate the beautiful Solemnity of All Saints. The Church is the Body of Christ: Jesus Christ is the Head, we are the members of His Body. Those of us who are joined to Christ exist not only in time, on this earth, but also in Purgatory and in Heaven. Thus the traditional distinction: the Church Militant (engaged in the battle), the Church Suffering (being purified), and the Church Triumphant (beholding God face to face). On All Saints' Day, we remember not just formally canonized Saints, but all those who stand "before the throne." We who are still engaged in the battle take courage from their example, and we ask for their prayers.

On Thursday, we will turn to the Church Suffering, all the "Holy Souls in Purgatory," as we celebrate All Souls' **Day.** Notice the "holy:" every soul in Purgatory will go to Heaven—their purification is not punishment, but more like physical therapy. It readies them to enter fully into God's joy! So, having asked the Saints to pray for us, we pray for the souls who are being purified... certainly our own family members and friends, but also all those who have no one to pray for them. God grant that we may greet them some day, in that Land of Joy, and that we may thank the Saints for their prayers, and those who were helped by our prayers may thank us!

I will be gone this coming week for training related to my vocations work. As I travel for vocations work, Rhen and I have been working to make sure I try to meet with our alumni and supporters as well. One of our senior priests, Fr. Frank Lenz will be covering for me. Friday Mass at St. Al's is cancelled (as is Tuesday Mass at St. Anne's). For All Saints' Day and All Souls' Day, the schedule is as follows:
