

From the desk of Fr. Ben... **26 November 2017**

On this last Sunday of the Liturgical Year (it would otherwise be the 34th Sunday of Ordinary Time), we mark each year the great Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ. King of the

Universe. In short we say, "Christ the King." It is a moment of solemn awe and joy at Jesus who reigns over all things, who governs all things well and sweetly.

In our Gospel, we encounter our loving Savior also as Judge. How does He judge us? In this passage from Matthew 25, He uses one criteria: "Amen, I say to you, whatever you did for one of the least brothers of mine, you did for me." Have we treated those we encounter as Christ Himself?

We have in our midst any number of opportunities to act on this truth. I would just like to express once again my gratitude for your generosity as a parish, and in a particular, I would like to acknowledge the work of our St. Al's Service Ministry, led by Carly Joseph and Alexis Dani, who have together set up regular events to serve our community. Coming up on Thursday, Dec. 14th, with the CHRISTmas Party, we'll have another chance to serve! Watch for more details next week.

Those of you who were in Sr. Jacqueline's Bible Study wrapped up the fall series recently. Thank you to all who participated, and above all to Sr. Jacqueline! In January a new series will begin, "A Biblical Journey through the Mass!"
