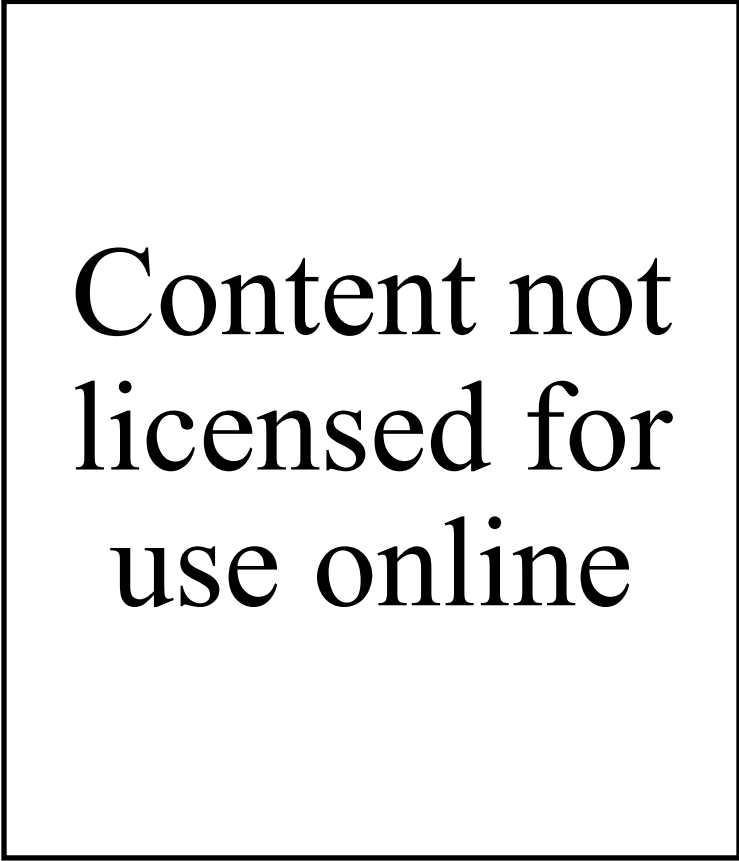
Having celebrated Pentecost, the Church now gives us three beautiful special feasts with which to enter back into Ordinary Time: this Sunday, the Solemnity of the **Most Holy Trinity**, next Sunday, the Solemnity of the **Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi)**, and then the Friday after that, the Solemnity of the **Most Sacred Heart of Jesus**.

The Bible tells us that "God is love," and we are able to make sense of that mysterious statement in the doctrine of the Trinity. God is one God, and three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Love is not meaningful apart from the gift of self to the other, and in the Trinity we see how that gift of self is possible within the Godhead. The Father loves the Son, the Son loves the Father, and the love between them is the Holy Spirit!
