St. Anne's Stained Glass Windows Project We now have some beautiful photos of the stained glass windows that we bought from St. Sebastian Parish in Bessemer. We hope to install them in the side entrance (beside and above the door), and possibly in the stairwell downstairs as well. Several families have already spoken to me about sponsoring a window. The cost per window to have them restored and installed will be in the \$12,000 to \$15,000 range (versus \$40,000 to \$60,000 to purchase new stained glass windows). 10 June 2018

The summer has arrived! It has come quickly! Congratulations to all the students and teachers and families who made it through another year of school, and a word of thanks to everyone who helped make our parish faith formation program possible at St. Anne's this past year, and especially to Sr. Jacqueline for her leadership!

We have entered back into Ordinary Time after all the power and beauty of the Lenten and Easter seasons! This liturgical season will stretch now all the way to the beginning of Advent this fall. It is the time of growth, conversion, and our ongoing journey with the Lord. How is the Lord calling you to grow, to fall deeper in love with Him? What's the next good step to respond to that call? Take some time to pray with those questions!

Sr. Jacqueline and I have spent this past week at the college seminary in Winona, MN, Immaculate Heart of Mary Seminary, on the campus of St. Mary's University. That is where we train our Totus Tuus missionaries, along with the dioceses of Superior & LaCrosse, WI; and Minneapolis/St. Paul and Winona, MN. Our 5 diocese bring together our teams (normally about 10 or 11) to prepare them for a summer of outreach in our dioceses!

We have 4 Totus Tuus teams this year, and 2 interns serving the UP, a total of 18 young adults! Please keep them in your prayers as they serve this summer.

THREE of the teams are coming here to the Copper Country to serve our local parishes, with St. Joseph Church hosting this year in Lake Linden THIS WEEK. Bring your kids and grandkids, even if you're not already registered!


