We continue to pray for all those affected by the flood.

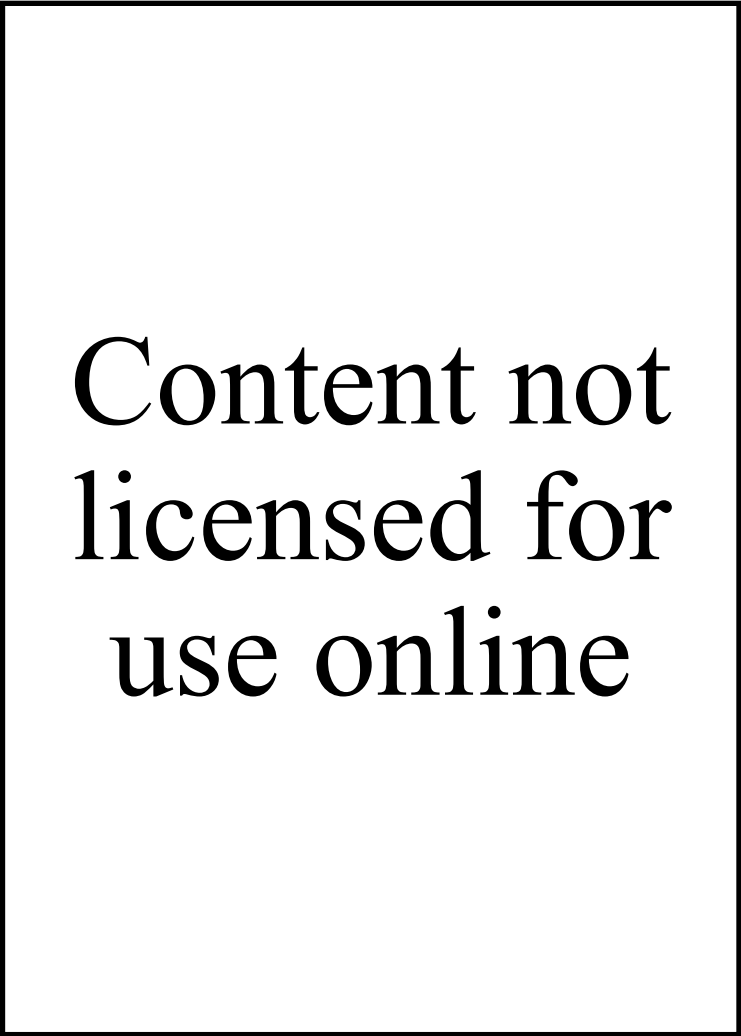

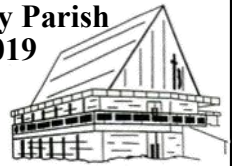
