Words of Wisdom from Bishop Frederic Baraga



"Then along came He, whose name is Love, and called me, a worldling, saying 'Go there also and I will give you what is just'

Behold, Lord here I am; give me what I need."
Frederic Baraga, to his sister, Amalia, Sept. 21, 1823

“Where do the wars and where do the conflicts among you come from? Is it not from your passions that make war within your members?”

James notices that human discord writ large (wars, injustice, family division, etc.) comes from our passions run amok on the micro level, in our hearts. If we seek “wisdom from above,” then other possibilities appear. We can be **“pure, then peaceable, gentle, compliant, full of mercy and good fruits, without inconstancy or insincerity.** And the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace for those who cultivate peace.”

I have included an insert from the US Conference of Catholic Bishops, the beginnings of an adequate response to the abuse scandal. Perhaps you or I can't impact that situation directly... but **we can cooperate with God's grace in our own hearts**, in our own homes, in our own parish, and in our own diocese. On those levels, not only can we make a difference, but it is necessarily up to us to make a difference.

Please continue to pray daily for Pope Francis, Bishop John, Fr. Dustin, me, and the whole Church.
