How to Report Abuse in the Diocese of Marquette

The Diocese of Marquette encourages individuals to report clergy, employee or volunteer sexual abuse of minors and others – no matter when the abuse occurred. For more than 15 years the diocese has had a "hotline" to Victims Assistance Coordinators for anyone to report abuse, which continues to be available.

Individuals may contact local law enforcement authorities and/or they may report to the Diocese of Marquette by calling one of the Victim Assistance Coordinators: Stephen Lynott at (844) 495-4330 or Diane Tryan at (844) 694-4362. Or by writing to Victims Assistance Coordinator, c/o Catholic Social Services of the UP, 1100 Ludington St. Suite 401, Escanaba MI 49829. Please mark the letter "Personal and Confidential" and indicate in your letter how you wish to be contacted (by phone or by letter).

Words of Wisdom from Bishop Frederic Baraga

Often Bishop Baraga would say, "I am essentially an Indian missionary."

From the desk of Fr. Ben...

28 October 2018

Our First Reading this Sunday has these VERY beautiful words from the Prophet Jeremiah:

"Behold, I will bring them back from the land of the north; I will gather them from the ends of the world, with the blind and the lame in their midst, the mothers and those with child; they shall return as an immense throng. They departed in tears, but I will console them and guide them; I will lead them to brooks of water, on a level road, so that none shall stumble."



Jeremiah was speaking into literal physical exile... but a physical exile which resulted from an interior one, an interior separation from God. Where is God calling you to turn back to Him, to allow Him to gather you

back to Himself? Where have you turned away from Him, a rejection of His love that has resulted in tears? He labors to love us and to bring us back, and He has the power to gather us to His love!

Do we believe and trust His power to bring us home, and to bring everyone in the whole world home to His love? To NO one does God say, "Go away, I can't love you!" To no one does God say, "your sin and failure are too big, I can't help you with my grace." Where can you and I start asking for the help we need in our daily lives?

On Monday, I head for Milwaukee early to visit Sacred Heart Seminary & School of Theology where Michael Kowalewski is in his final year of seminary. I'll be meeting Bishop John there, and then on Tuesday I'll be heading to the seminary in Florida for another week of training with the Seminary Formation Council. On both ends of that trip I'll be meeting with St. Al's alumni as well.

We have two beautiful liturgical celebrations: All Saints' Day (a holy day of obligation) and All Souls' Day. We who are in the battle (the Church Militant) ask the prayers of those who stand before God's throne (the Church Glorious), and we pray for those who are being purified (the Church Suffering). Masses are as follows:

- + All Saints': 9 pm Weds, St. Al's; 9 am & 5:30 pm Thurs St. Anne's, and 12:15 pm Thurs. St. Al's.
- + All Souls': 9 am Fri., St. Anne's, & 5:30 pm Friday, St. Al's.
