Who is St. Albert the Great, our Patron Saint?



Born in Lauingen, Swabia (now southern Germany) in his family's castle along the Danube River around the year 1200AD, St. Albert joined the newly founded Order of Preachers, aka the Dominicans, in 1223 while a student at the University of Padua. He became widely renowned for his knowledge of the natural sciences, & also as the teacher and mentor of St. Thomas Aquinas. He studied & taught in Paris, Köln (Cologne), & Rome, and in 1260 he was named bishop of Regensburg (Ratisbon). Having resolved many administrative, financial, & pastoral problems there, in 1262 he resigned his bishopric & returned to teaching & research. Vigorous & clear in mind until late in life, he died on Nov. 15, 1280 in Cologne, where he is buried in St. Andrea's Church. He was beatified in 1622 & canonized in 1931, when Pope Pius XI also named him a "Doctor of the Church." He is patron of the natural sciences, scientists, & students.

“Amen, I say to you, this poor widow put in more than all the other contributors to the treasury. For they have all contributed from their surplus wealth, but she, from her poverty, has contributed all she had, her whole livelihood.”

Biblical scholars actually think we know what the two small coins looked like! They were worth very little, and even were rather crudely made... but

they were, as Jesus tells us, “all she had.”



Do we give our whole selves to God? I am very proud of how generous our parish is in many ways, not least very practical things like the Sunday collection, community service, special collections, etc.!!! And, yet, I know that I often struggle to surrender my whole heart to God, even more than my income! **Where might God be calling you to a more complete gift of yourself?**

This weekend, we also have the joy of celebrating our patron, St. Albert the Great! His feastday is properly Nov. 15th, but we avail ourselves of the liturgical option of moving the celebration to a nearby weekend. We express our devotion to our patron saints in many outward signs so as to foster a profound inward effect: that we would call upon our patron saints in time of need, that we would seek their intercession for our loved ones and friends, and that we would learn from the rich treasure of their lives and writings. **St. Albert loved God, loved and served God’s Church, and he loved science... what a wonderful patron for our St. Al’s community! By God’s grace and St. Albert’s intercession, may we love God, serve His Church, and use our gifts and talents well!**

As I type this, I’m sitting in a coffee shop near Washington D.C., nearly at the end of 10 days of travel! After a seminary visit near Milwaukee, I’ve flown to Tampa, FL, driven across Florida, had 5 days of training, flown to Dallas, and then to DC! Part of this has been related to my work as Vocations Director, and part to staying connected to our St. Al’s alumni. I have had meals with two of our retired priests, held a recent graduates’ first child, and driven three different rental cars in 4 different states and the District of Columbia! **I’m really glad I’ll be back home this weekend!**

This past Monday, Fr. Dustin headed out for a silent retreat at a really great retreat center in Clearwater, FL. Each year every priest is to spend a week, more or less, in recollection and prayer. I made my retreat in June as part of the same training program I was part of last week. **Please keep Fr. Dustin in your prayers, that God may refresh and renew him!**

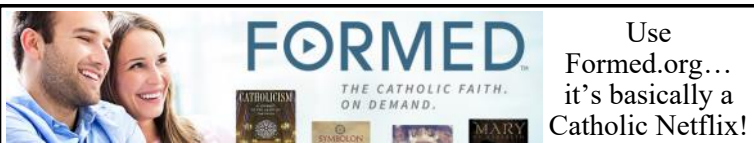
